The first priority of any family planning program when considering partner engagement is to respect the client's preference of whether to engage her partner and to do so in equitable ways that protect and encourage women's autonomy. This SPG provides four key steps that can be taken by organizations to engage men and boys in family planning programming to improve sexual and reproductive health.
